#### Assembly Recap (6/7):

- **Bill** provided Return on Rotary through May 2022 with \$4,600 in donations and 219 volunteer hours.
- **Nate** reported a total of 18 donations were made from the Vitalant Blood Drive.
- A motion was made and seconded to partner with the Denver Southeast Rotary Club in giving \$500 monetary donation and \$2,000 in DDF to the Cameroon Water Project in West Central Africa. A request was made that someone from the Southeast Club come to speak about this project.
- Nate reported we are scheduled to meet and greet at the Central Park Everleigh 55+ Community Facility on June 28, from 4:00-6:00 PM. Our club will provide refreshments and meat & cheese trays. There will be no morning meeting on this date.
- Tom provided summary of Membership and Area Giving with 15 active members (goal set at 17), annual fund goal of \$3,000 (presently at \$1,985), polio giving of \$1,000 (met). He provided Paul Harris Fellow data as of June 2022 on all members and summary of Club Recognition. In order for our club to receive the Citation Award, we must achieve Every Rotarian EVERY Year status, which means Every member of our club personally contributes a monetary amount (\$1, \$20, \$25, or more) to the Rotary Foundation's Annual Fund.
- **Greg** reported there is no change in our club's accounts and there will be two big fundraisers coming up WooHoomanity Challenge and the Peaches/Pears Sales.
- **Nate** suggested our club continue to think about future events/projects and keep in mind our goal setting of funds.
